ABOUT THE SCHOOL AND THE CITY

Instituto Interamericano de Idiomas, S.A., internationally known as Intensa reflecting its "intensive" language programs, was founded in 1980. Currently, Instituto Interamericano de Idiomas, S.A. offers second language programs in Spanish and relies on a highly qualified teaching staff. The length of the Spanish study program can be as short as two weeks or as long as six months.

The northwest central valley town of Alajuela is Costa Rica's second city. Alajuela has a busy downtown area and a slightly warmer climate than nearby San Jose. The International Airport is just one kilometer from the town. A provincial capital, Alajuela's red domed cathedral completes its central square and park which, during the heat of the afternoon, is the perfect place to hang out and people watch.

ABOUT THE PROGRAM

We specialize in offering immersion Spanish programs for people who desire to speak and read Spanish in a reasonably short period of time. With this objective in mind, our programs emphasize intensive conversation practice. We have found this to be one of the most effective and rapid ways of learning to converse and read in Spanish.

Students arrive in Alajuela with different language backgrounds. Consequently placement tests are given on the first day of classes to place students into small groups which match their conversational level. The groups range from complete beginner to advanced. Students will be moved to different groups as their Spanish improves to ensure they are always receiving the best instruction for their current language level. Under certain circumstances there may not be a group which matches the students current level. When this occurs the student will be given 3 hours of individual (one-on-one) lessons instead of 4 lessons in a group. This ensures that students should never feel like they are being over/underwhelmed by the course content. Small groups classes (and individual lessons) ensure you will receive the attention and extensive oral practice so essential to developing your language ability.

Custom text materials have been developed and are given to each student attending classes. The customized material uses a well-established language acquisition program, providing live, meaningful situations in which students can acquire communicative competence in speaking and reading Spanish. Performance objectives for language structures, culture, and pronunciation are clearly delineated as well as functional conversational goals.

Students who start later than Monday will not be able to make up missed hours. Lessons are not held on national holidays.

Basic Spanish Programs

Tutor 15, 20 & 25 hours per week. These programs include 2, 3, 4 or more weeks of study consisting of 3 to 5 lessons per day, Monday through Friday. Each lesson averages 53 minutes in length in a group setting or a tutorial. All programs stress maximum practice in conversation, under the direct guidance of a staff teacher.

ACCOMMODATIONS

Homestays The host families are from the Costa Rican middle class; most have had foreign students as guests before. Instituto Interamericano de Idiomas, S.A. will make every reasonable effort to match you and your interests with an appropriate family. The homestay includes a private room, and laundry service plus a good breakfast and a main meal. Homes are within easy commuting distance from the school. Students will be placed one student per family.

SPECIAL ACTIVITIES

The school has supplemented the instruction program with a cultural program which includes field trips, Latin American dance lessons, and tours through the lush, green, picturesque countryside and to breathtaking tropical beaches.
